





#### SNA's Position Paper & Trends Report

SNA released their 2026 Position Paper and the SY 2025-26 School Nutrition Trends Report, ahead of the release of the 2025-2030 Dietary Guidelines for Americans (DGA), which calls for a reduction in highly processed foods.

[The 2026 SNA Position Paper](#), outlining the Association's advocacy priorities for the year, urges Congress to:

1. Increase investments in school meal programs to cover rising costs, expand scratch cooking, and provide students more fresh, local produce.
2. Protect and expand access to healthy school meals for all students.
3. Ensure updates to federal school nutrition standards are feasible for schools.

[The Trends Report](#), an analysis of survey responses from 1,240 SN Directors nationwide, provides evidence to support the Paper's request.
